Following the Sunrise Service, you are invited to join together with those at the service for breakfast in Temple's social hall. (The service is approximate ½ hour or slightly less. It is outdoors, so please dress warmly!)

Bishop John R. Schol has appointed the Rev. Michael S. Remel as the new pastor of our congregation. Rev. Remel will begin his new responsibilities on July 1. As a United Methodist Church we are a part of the appointment system. Our congregation's Leadership Board as Staff Parish Relations has met with the district superintendent to identify our congregation's needs and the needed skills as a Pastor. We have also met with Rev. Remel to better get to know him and ask questions.

Pastor Mike is a graduate of Pen Argyl High School, has an undergraduate degree from East Stroudsburg University, and a Master of Divinity Degree from Palmer Theological Seminary. He has one son, Shawn, age 23. Pastor Mike has been in the ministry for 26 years and in that time he has served churches in Northeast and Central Pennsylvania.

One of his strongest gifts for ministry is connecting churches with their community. Other strengths include a compassion for others and the ability to engage folks in ways that will lead to faith in Christ, as well as equip them for giving leadership to some aspect of ministry in the local church. All New GriefShare Set to Begin in March

We have offered the GriefShare program for more than a year here at Cedarville Church, hosting four 13week sessions. The positive feedback we've received has indicated we have helped many individuals who are grieving a loss.

We're ready to start a new session on March 6. And we're set to use brand new GriefShare materials as we roll out the fourth edition.

What is GriefShare? It's a weekly video seminar featuring some of the nation's foremost experts on grief recovery topics. Each seminar is combined with a small group discussion time to allow group participants to talk about the content of the seminar and about how they are dealing with the death of their loved one. A modest registration fee will include a participants guide with short daily questions, insights, and Bible verses which can make a difference for those experiencing loss.

Our next session will be held every Wednesday evening from March 6 through May 29 from 6:30 p.m.-8:30 p.m. in room 105.


Walter Mouse Devotional
